Teresa then moved to Arizona and completed her college studies and graduated from Arizona State University with a degree in the performing arts.

Following college Teresa married & subsequently had a son (Connor).

She moved to Denver and then to Central City, Colorado, where she and her husband Kevin lived on a lovely acreage in the mountains at 9400 feet elevation.

She and her husband loved life and people. They were very engaged in their religion and developed a large circle of friends. She has touched the hearts of very many people. She actively performed in several plays in Arizona, Denver, and Central City. During the last two months of 2009 her medical condition deteriorated and she passed away on Dec 12th, 2009. Six days earlier she had just celebrated the 20th anniversary of her liver transplant. She was 39 years old. She is survived by her husband Kevin, son Connor, five brothers, two sisters, her mother and father, and several nieces & nephews.
